Competition Terms and Conditions

1. Introduction

3. How to enter

Participants who want to activate ten bonus entries must complete this form.

3.3. The Competition opens on Friday 19 July.

3.4. Entries must be received by 11.30pm Sunday 4 August 2024 (AWST). Entries received after this time will not be considered.

3.5. Participants may submit as many entries as they like.

4. Prizes
